

Wage subsidy (CEWS) taken by political parties

- Liberal Party of Canada = \$1,253,831
- <u>Conservative Party of Canada</u> = \$1,083,246
- New Democratic Party of Canada = \$325,000¹
- Green Party of Canada = \$576,001
- <u>British Columbia Liberal Party</u> = \$329,603
- Green Party of British Columbia = \$43,302²
- <u>United Conservative Party of Alberta</u> = \$151,445
- <u>Manitoba Liberal Party</u> = \$25,596
- Liberal Party of Newfoundland and Labrador = \$35,669³

¹ The NDP's annual financial statement does not include the total amount received through the Canada Emergency Wage Subsidy. This is a CTF estimate based on an NDP spokesperson saying the party received between $\frac{60,000 \text{ to}}{570,000}$ per claim period and intended to apply for <u>five claim periods</u> (\$65,000 x 5 = \$325,000).
