

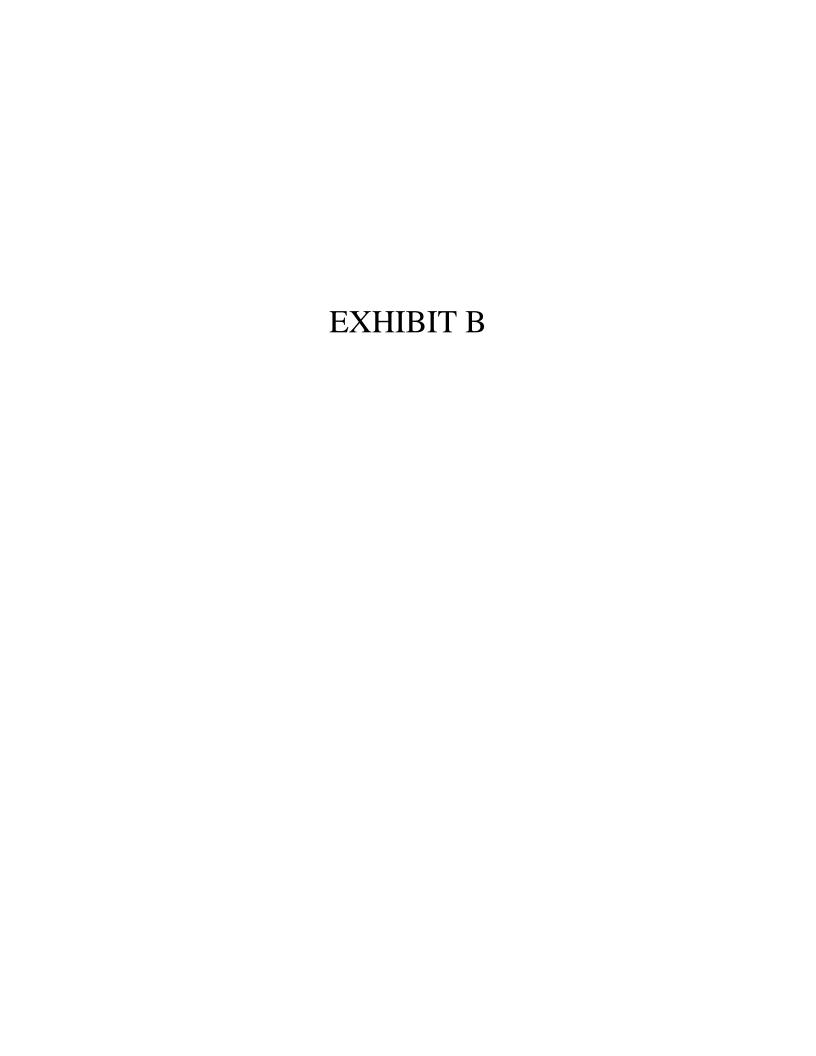

Adam Paul Laxalt, Outside Counsel

Adam Paul Laxalt served as Nevada's 33rd Attorney General from 2015-2019, entering office as the youngest Attorney General in the country at the time.

Laxalt graduated Magna Cum Laude from Georgetown University and also graduated from Georgetown University Law Center.

Laxalt is a former Naval Officer and Iraq Veteran. Laxalt served as a Special Assistant U.S. Attorney and as an Assistant Professor of Law in the Leadership, Ethics, and the Law Department at the U.S. Naval Academy.

As Nevada's Attorney General and top law-enforcement officer, Laxalt took a bold, results-driven approach to serving the people of Nevada, protecting the state's most vulnerable citizens, and keeping its communities safe.

One of Laxalt's top priorities was pursing justice for victims of sexual assault, which he did by taking on Nevada's horrendous backlog of more than 8,000 untested sexual-assault evidence kits. He also fought for victims of human trafficking, and secured the first human-trafficking conviction in the history of his office. In addition, he led efforts to protect Nevada's seniors, creating a financial fraud unit to address issues including abuse of the elderly and guardianship exploitation.

Today, Laxalt lives in Reno with his wife, Jaime, their daughters Sophia and Isabella, their baby boy, Jack, and their dog, Buckley.



Caitlin Sutherland, Executive Director

After spending the last decade working for nonprofits and advocacy groups, Caitlin Sutherland joins Americans for Public Trust as the founding Executive Director.

Sutherland graduated Magna Cum Laude from Saint Mary's College in Notre Dame, Indiana. Since, Sutherland has helped lead issue advocacy and voter education campaigns for a variety of organizations. Most recently, she served as the Deputy Research Director at the Senate Leadership Fund and the Research Director at the NRCC.

In addition to her professional experience, Sutherland has volunteered her time with grassroots voter engagement efforts for state and federal campaigns.
