



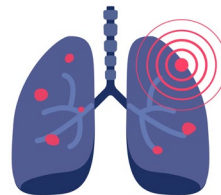
# Impacts of High Rx Prices to New Jersey Residents



**685,586** New Jersey residents diagnosed with cancer.<sup>1</sup>

**Revlimid**

treats forms of cancer

from \$185,574/yr  
to **\$267,583/yr<sup>2</sup>**

**Victoza**

treats diabetes

from \$7,936/yr  
to **\$11,300/yr<sup>2</sup>**

**Spiriva Handihaler**

treats asthma/COPD

from \$3,886/yr  
to **\$5,289/yr<sup>2</sup>**
