Small Businesses Say Congress Should Prioritize Election Security & Economic Relief Over Supreme Court Nominee

KEY FINDINGS


- From Oct. 2-5, Small Business for America's Future conducted an online survey of 1,511 small business owners in its national network.
- The pandemic continues to hit small business owners hard, with 15% saying their businesses can only survive through October without further federal relief and 34% saying they can only make it to the end of 2020.
- When asked about Congressional priorities, 87% of small business owners identified something other than the Supreme Court nomination: 52% say that Congress should pass a new economic relief package and 27% said Congress should focus on election security. Just 14% said the Supreme Court vacancy should be the top priority.
- 65% are concerned with election integrity and 66% of those say an unclear result would have negative consequences for the economy.
- 98% of small business owners plan to vote.

 15% of small business owners say they can only survive through the end of October without further federal financial assistance and 34% say they can survive to the end of the year


How long will your small business be able to survive without another round of federal financial assistance?






RESULTS: SMALL BUSINESSES ARE STILL STRUGGLING

- 28% of small business owners have considered closing their business permanently due to Covid-19
- 19% are facing the possibility of declaring bankruptcy due to Covid-19









RESULTS: SMALL BUSINESSES WANT CONGRESS TO FOCUS ON ECONOMY & ELECTION

 87% of survey respondents say Congress should prioritize issues other than the Supreme Court nomination; 52% believe Congress should focus on passing a Covid relief package









RESULTS: SMALL BUSINESS OWNERS ARE WORRIED ABOUT ELECTION INTEGRITY

 66% of survey respondents said they are worried about the integrity of the upcoming presidential election








RESULTS: SMALL BUSINESS OWNERS ARE WORRIED ABOUT ELECTION INTEGRITY

- 98% of survey respondents are planning to vote
- 62% of those who plan to vote say they will vote early


If you plan to vote, when do you plan to do so?


