

The APP Montana General Election Survey was conducted by IVR Interviews and Online Mobile from July 11 - July 16 among a random sample of 700 likely voters. The survey has a margin of error of +/- 3.7 percentage points. Results are weighted. Some percentages in crosstab reports for this poll may not add to 100% due to rounding.

Are you 18 years of age and registered to vote in the state of Montana?



How likely are you to vote in the November 3rd General Election in Montana? Would you say you are extremely likely, somewhat likely, or not very likely?


















Do you agree or disagree with the following statement? "I am proud to be an American."





If you learned Black Lives Matter supported doing away with the traditional family, would you be more or less likely to support Black Lives Matter?



If you learned Black Lives Matter supported defunding police departments nationwide, would you be more or less likely to support Black Lives Matter?





Should boys and men who say they identify as transgender be allowed to compete in girls' and women's athletics?



Should children who say they identify as transgender be allowed to undergo physical sex change surgeries or chemical treatments while they are under the age of 18?








Do you consider yourself to be Very conservative, Somewhat Conservative, Moderate, Somewhat Liberal or Very Liberal?



What is your gender?








What is your total household income?




